Pre-Enrolment Dates & Open House	 Complete Pre-Enrolment Online in SchoolZone between Monday, February 3 and Wednesday, March 19, 2025 (by 4:00 p.m.). Our Mary Butterworth School Open House will be held on Wednesday, February 26, 2025, from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. (Doors open at 5:45 p.m. Gym presentation from 6:00 to 6:30 p.m.)
Designated Attendance Area	 Resident students who live within the Mary Butterworth School Attendance Area are guaranteed admission during pre-enrolment. (Go to https://epsb.ca/schools/findaschool/fast/ to find what your designated junior high school is.) Proof of Address is required by providing the following documentation: mortgage/lease agreement, driver's license, utility bill, home insurance, property tax bill.
After Pre-Enrolment - Closed Grades	 It is <u>highly likely</u> that Mary Butterworth School will be full in planned classes in all grades immediately following pre-enrolment on March 20, 2025. Once we are full in planned classes, we cannot accept designated area students who pre-enrolled elsewhere. We can only then accept resident students who have newly moved into the school's attendance area.

NOTE: For our alternative Academic Enrichment program classes, we accept students in the following order: Resident students who live in Mary Butterworth School's attendance area. Siblings of students currently in an MBS AEP class and who will be returning to MBS for the 2025-2026 school year. Other resident students. Other non-resident students. *Difference between Resident and Non-Resident Students: The Division is required by provincial legislation to serve resident students first. A resident student of Edmonton Public Schools typically has at least one parent or legal guardian living in Edmonton who is not Roman Catholic.
Option Course Selection	 In mid-May 2025, we will contact pre-enrolled students to complete their Option Selection Forms. (They will be emailed to parents and also sent to grade 6 EPSB classes.)
Grade 7 Orientation	 On the first day of school, which is Tuesday, September 2, 2025, we invite grade 7 students and parents into the gym to start with a grade 7 orientation from 8:35 to 9:30 a.m., and then the grade 7s will go with their homeroom teachers.

Siblings of Current Students	Siblings of current Mary Butterworth School students who are returning to MBS for the 2025-2026 school year are guaranteed admission during pre-enrolment. You can indicate a sibling when you complete pre-enrolment in SchoolZone.
Remaining Spaces for Students who Live Outside our Attendance Area & Random Selection	 It is highly likely that Mary Butterworth School will have spaces for students who live outside the attendance area. It is possible that we will need to conduct Random Selection (https://epsb.ca/schools/register/randomselection/) as we anticipate that we will have more enrolment requests than available spaces. (Go to https://epsb.ca/schools/findaschool/fast/ to find what your designated junior high school is.) Between April 1 and April 11, 2025, we will contact all non-designated students about their enrolment status (including random selection). For any students who are not accepted through random selection, they can attend their designated school or any other Division school with available space.
After Pre-Enrolment - Closed Grades	 It is <u>highly likely</u> that Mary Butterworth School will be full in planned classes in all grades immediately following pre-enrolment on March 20, 2025. Once we are full in planned classes, we only then accept <i>resident students who have newly moved into the school's attendance area (proof of new address is required).</i>
